#### Covid-19 Contingency Plan

We are returning to term time with increased Covid levels and with the usual winter bugs. This can mean that, as before Christmas, we may be faced with staff shortages which will affect our ratios. Following our outbreak management plan, and as a last resort, we may have to limit our children's numbers to maintain safe ratios. We will always consult with you before using this but you can help us by letting us know if your child is not coming in

for any reason so we have accurate numbers to plan ahead with.

### Facemasks at pick up/drop off

A gentle reminder, please wear a facemask at pickup/drop off when on the nursery premises.

#### Primary school applications

If your child was born between  $1^{st}$  September 2017 and  $31^{st}$  August 2018, you need to apply for Reception for September 2022. For the pre-schoolers due to start Primary school in September 2022, you can apply online for a primary school place. The deadline for receipt of primary school applications is  $15^{th}$  January 2022.

Weather appropriate clothing: Waterproof coat, gloves, hat and boots.

As the weather is getting cold, wet and frosty we will still be going into the garden to play and to get some fresh air, please make sure that your children have weather appropriate clothing (waterproof coat, gloves, hat and boots). Please make sure all your children's belongings are clearly labelled with their name - we often have so many duplicates of hats, coats, shoes, and wellies that it is difficult to identify whose is whose.

the things that the children need and to label EVERYTHING!

Please take a look at the photo with the items on our lost property table and let us know if any of these belong to your child.
