Session Increases for April 2018

If you would like to increase your sessions after Easter, please email or speak to me as soon as possible. Children who are turning 3 before 31^{st} March 2018 are entitled to 15 or possibly 30 funded hours after Easter so please let me know if you are planning on increasing your hours to reflect this. I will get the Parental Contracts from the Early Years Funding team to you soon, so please come and see me if you have any questions or would like some help arranging the extra sessions.

Tapestry Online Journal

We will be using the Tapestry online journal from April for all children who will be returning to us in September 2018. We are currently trialing the system with the children who joined us in January and February but will now gradually transfer the remaining children's records to Tapestry. I will be sending information and permission letters to you all, and when we are ready to go 'live' I will also ensure you all have guides on how to access the system from your own devices. Until then we will be happy to show you your children's profiles on the iPads if you would like us to. Unfortunately we won't be adding preschool children to the system as there will only be one term left once it is properly up and running. We will however continue to contribute to the children's folders - any group photographs with preschool children will still be used in the same way; younger children's photographs will be added to their Tapestry profile but photographs with preschool child's folder. Videos will be shared with parents on the camera or iPad, by showing them to parents on the device for preschool aged children or added to younger children's profiles. More information on Tapestry will follow but please feel free to ask any questions.


Themes for this Half Term:
