### **30-hour funding codes**

Please can I remind parents/carers that have qualified for the 30-hour funding that you need to do an eligibility check every 3 months with HMRC from when you were first given the code. HMRC should send you a reminder by email. Also, if you will start claiming Early Years Funding in January and you think you might be eligible for the 30 hours extended entitlement then please make sure that you get your code before 31/12/2021 to start January 2021, (where possible can Mandy have the code by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> December). If you do not get the code by the end of December you will not be able to claim 30 hours until April 2021. These are strict cut off dates which have been issued by government.

### **Drop off and pick up**

We are having quite a few early arrivals or late pick ups of children at the moment. We understand that on odd occasions traffic can be a problem and in these circumstances we would ask that you phone to say you will be late. Bookings are made by the hour and staffing requirements are arranged by number and age of children on premises, late pick ups or early arrivals can have an effect on child/staff ratios.
